### Notice to All Junior College Students


**This is to inform all Junior College students of the following rules and regulations that must be adhered to while on campus:**

1. All students must wear their issued Identity Cards at all times within the College premises. Failure to do so will result in denial of access to lectures, practicals etc. And fine of Rs 100 will be collected from the student for not wearing the ID card. Ensure your Identity Card displays a recent photograph and the Principal's signature. It must be available for inspection by College Authorities and Security Staff upon request.
2. Students are required to be on time for all lectures and classes.
3. Students should not share any College-related information with the media, including social media platforms, without prior permission from the Principal. Violations will be subject to disciplinary action under the IT Act, 2000.
4. Serious violations of College rules, including disobedience, misconduct, or any form of indiscipline, can result in loss of academic term or expulsion.
5. Students must respect College property. Any damage, including disfigurement of walls, doors, and misuse of equipment, will lead to fines or suspension.
6. Smoking, tobacco use, drug and alcohol consumption are strictly prohibited. Violations will result in expulsion.
7. The use of mobile phones, walkmans, and similar devices is not allowed on College premises except for attendance purpose in class. And fine of Rs. 500/- will be collected if caught using Mobile Phone in the class. Students can use mobile phone in canteen, at the ground floor entrance, upavan and college ground.
8. Students should not collect money for any purpose (e.g., picnics, trips, study materials etc.)
9. Ragging is strictly prohibited. Offenders will be prosecuted under the Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1999.
10. No student should bring outsider in college premises.
11. Unauthorized photography or videography of College areas, including classrooms and labs, is not permitted.

Violation of all these rules and regulations will attract strict disciplinary action against the student/s concerned.
